A Stroll with the Mayor

Role of Telephone Exchange Stations

There has been remarkable progress in communication devices, from landlines to mobile phones and now to smartphones. We now live in a society where it is possible to do many things with just one smartphone, such as making various payments, completing procedures, managing bank accounts, and booking tickets.

A telecommunications facility that has been supporting the lives of Urayasu City residents is the NTT East telephone exchange station located along the Sakaigawa River in Tomioka 1-chome. This exchange station was established in its current location 52 years ago in 1972 as a branch of the Ichikawa Telephone Exchange Station to handle the rapid increase in telephone subscriptions.

In 1983, a service window was set up in this exchange station to handle telephone subscriptions, fee payments and the like. This service window was in operation until 2002, when many service windows were consolidated to increase management efficiency.

It has been 22 years since the service window was closed, and many residents may not even know that a telephone exchange station exists here. However, the exchange station is still an indispensable part of the lives of our residents.

In addition to relay antennas that connect longdistance locations, there are antennas for mobile phones and the like on the upper part of the building. Inside the building, there is equipment necessary for communication, making it a facility that ensures a good communication network in the city during peacetime. In addition, Urayasu City and NTT East Japan have agreed to cooperate in the event of a disaster, and the exchange station plays necessary roles such as securing

an emergency communications network, collaborating with other telecommunications providers and disaster prevention administrative radio, and dispatching mobile power supply vehicles and portable satellite vehicles.

The city will continue to promote digitization in all fields, including electronic applications for various procedures, while continuing to work with telecommunications companies and other related organizations to ensure convenience and to respond to disasters.
